Sylvester N. Hauersperger, 83, of Grinnell died of heart failure Sunday, July 23, at Friendship Manor.

Funeral services are set for 10 a.m. Tuesday at Wallace-Pence Funeral Home in Newton, with the Rev. Mary Schnepf, associate pastor of First United Methodist Church of Newton, officiating. Burial will be in Newton Union Cemetery.
