Richard M. Hayes, 62, of Rte. 1, Tama, died of cancer Monday, Jan. 14, at his home.

The Funeral Mass was celebrated at 11 a.m. Thursday at St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Tama, with burial in St. Patrick's Cemetery. A memorial fund has been established.

The son of Justin F. and Betty Picray Hayes, he was born May 2, 1928, in Dubuque. He attended elementary school in Monticello, graduating from Tama High School in 1947.

He was married to Darlene J. Kupka Oct. 17, 1956, in Tama. Mr. Hayes worked for Concrete Materials Corp. of LeGrand, later joining Martin-Marietta Stone Co. in Malcom, serving as plant manager for 13 years until his retirement in December 1989.
