Armour Heidt services held

1 / Armour P. Heidt, 62, of Waverly died suddenly early Saturday at the home of his son, Michael P. Heidt, 1313 Main St., Grinnell. He had been visiting here after a trip to Arkansas.

Funeral services for Mr. Heidt were held Tuesday at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Waverly, with burial at Harlington Cemetery there.

The son of Daniel and Mary Clifford Heidt, he was born Nov. 5, 1914, at Jesup, Ia. He was graduated from East High School, Waterloo, in 1933. On Nov. 11, 1938, he was married to Marguerite (Peg) McMullen in Waterloo. They farmed near Hazleton, moving to a farm near Waverly in 1948. Mr. Heidt later worked as a bridge foreman in Chickasaw County, and he assumed a similar position in Bremer County in 1959. In 1969, he became superintendent of parks and cemeteries in Waverly, a position he held until his retirement in March of this year.

Mr. Heidt is survived by his wife; one daughter, Mrs. John A. (Patricia Anne) Stone of Dexheim, West Germany; two sons, Michael of Grinnell and Daniel J. Heidt of Waverly; one brother; four sisters; and two granddaughters.

He was preceded in death by his parents, three sisters and two brothers.
