Lester Heishman, 90, died Tuesday morning, Oct. 10, at St. Francis Manor following a stroke.

A funeral service will be held Friday, Oct. 13, at 1:30 p. m. at Sheridan United Methodist Church with the Rev. William Schlobohm officiating and burial will be in Sheridan Church Cemetery. Visitation at Harrison Funeral Home, Tama, was to take place Wednesday evening and another visitation will take place Friday from 9 to 11 a. m. at St. Francis Manor. A memorial in Mr. Heishman's name has been established.
