Aug. 26, 1896, she was married to William H. Baltisberger. The couple had four children, Hilda Hall of Malcom, Harvey Baltisberger of Marshalltown, Carl Baltisberger of Des Moines, and a son who died in infancy. Mr. Baltisberger died in July, 1921.
