Thomas Jesse Hendrickson, the son of Jens and Serina Hendrickson, was born near Brooklyn in Poweshiek county, Iowa, August 29, 1893, and died at the Deaconess hospital in Marshalltown of pneumonia and encephalitis on Feb. 23, 1934, having reached the age of 40 years, 5 months and 25 days.

His early life was spent near Brooklyn, where he attended the rural schools and later operated his father's farm. On June 19, 1920, he was united in marriage to Carrie A. Horrigan. To this union was born one daughter, Esther Serena.

In 1922 the family moved to California, where Jesse was employed in the Civil Service.

In 1927 the family returned to Iowa where they resumed farming, living near Toledo at the present time.

In early manhood he was united with the Christian church of Madison township, of which he still remains a member. He had a wide circle of friends who deeply mourn his passing. He was a loyal and true husband, a loving father, and a kind brother and son. He leaves to mourn his death his wife and daughter, Esther, his father, an invalid mother, one brother, Henry, of Brooklyn, five sisters, Mrs. Ellen Lang, Mrs. Ruth Keller, Mrs. Stella Lang, all of Brooklyn, Mrs. Louise Phillips of DeSoto, and Hazel, at home.

Funeral services were held from the church at Haven, with Rev. W. B. Wilson in charge. Burial was made in the Haven cemetery.
