

## Ruth Henning rites Thursday

Ruth Elizabeth Henning, 93, of Grinnell died Monday, July 17, at Friendship Manor.

Funeral services were conducted at 10 a.m. Thursday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Philo J. Ramstad, pastor of the United Church of Christ Congregational, officiating. Organist was Alice Renard. Burial was in Evergreen Cemetery, Fairfield.

The daughter of the Rev. and Mrs. L. H. Henning, she was born on July 27, 1894, at Norwood, Ill. She lived in Norwood and Mt. Airy, Ill., and in Dexter before moving to Montezuma. She graduated from Montezuma High School in 1910, then attended Huron College in South Dakota, graduating in 1917. She received her master's degree from the University of Illinois in 1920.

Miss Henning taught

mathematics at Mesabi Junior College in Virginia, Minn., until moving to Grinnell in 1976. She was a member of the United Church of Christ Congregational, the DAR, Delta Kappa Gamma Society, the Poweshiek County Retired Teachers Association, and the American Association of University Women.

She is survived by a brother, John L. Henning of Grinnell. She was preceded in death by her parents.
