Rites held for Mr. Henning

Walter A. Henning, 75, of Kellogg and a former mayor of that community, died Tuesday, Feb. 12, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services for Mr. Henning were conducted at 2 p.m. Friday, Feb. 15, at the Wallace-Pence Funeral Home in Newton, with the Rev. Robert Hinshaw of the Ashton Chapel officiating. Burial was in Newton Memorial Park Cemetery.

The son of August F. and Frederica Sak Henning, he was born Jan. 26, 1910, at Newton. He attended Newton schools.

On Dec. 21, 1929, he was married to Mamie Schermerhorn
