Mrs. Barbara Henry, 86, of rural Deep River died at her home Tuesday afternoon, April 10.

The daughter of James B. and Mary Ellen Harry McFerren, she was born July 21, 1886, in Scott Township, Poweshiek County. She was married to Joseph Henry Feb. 12, 1913, in the home of her parents. Mrs. Henry lived all of her life in Scott Township. She was a graduate of Montezuma High School.

She joined the Methodist Church in Montezuma at the age of 14. Following her marriage, Mrs. Henry became a member of the Fairview United Presbyterian Church. She later transferred to the Grace United Methodist Church of Brooklyn. Mrs. Henry was a charter member of the Fairview Willing Workers Club and the Fairview Ladies Aid. She was superintendent of the Fairview Union Sunday School for several years.
