Donald Herbert, 67, of Marshalltown, formerly of Grinnell, died Friday, Dec. 16, at Marshalltown Medical and Surgical Center.

Memorial services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday at Hope United Methodist Church in Marshalltown, with the Rev. Richard Jenkins officiating. Burial will be in Hazelwood Cemetery, Grinnell.

A Donald Herbert Memorial Fund has been established.

He was the son of Paul and Mabel Dorothy Hansen Herbert and was born Aug. 1, 1927, in Atlantic. He was raised and educated in Vinton and graduated from Grinnell High School.
