Word has been received here of the death at Sylvan, Wash. Feb. 28, of Mrs. S. B. Herrick a longtime resident of Grinnell universally respected by all. Of her death the Tacoma Ledger of March 3 says:

Mrs. Lucy A. Herrick died at her home at Rosemon, Sylvan, Saturday morning of heart trouble. Mrs. Herrick had been ill since the death of her husband three years ago in May, but the end, coming suddenly Saturday morning, was a shock to the whole community.

Lucy Anna Lane was born in Elyria. Obio, 81 years ago next June. She was married at the age of 18 to Stephen Bradford Herrick and in 1870 moved to Grinnell, Iowa, where they lived until 1880, when they came to Sylvan. The were among the pioneers of this place.

Mrs. Herrick was prominent in church work and in all things for the uplifting of the community in which she lived. She was of an artistic temperament, dearly loving all things beautiful and used her brush in landscape painting until within about a year of her death.

The funeral service was held Monday morning from the Sylvan church, of which she was one of the charter members. The service was conducted by the pastor, C. F. Nevius, and Rev. Edgar Wheeler of Tacoma, a friend and neighbor for many years. The abun-
