## Anne Herzberg rites Thursday

Anne S. Herzberg, the daughter of Char Herzberg of 1816 Spring St., Grinnell, died following a seizure Monday, Jan. 28, in the emergency room at Marshalltown Area Community Hospital.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. Thursday at the Trinity Lutheran Church near Malcom, with the Rev. Gerald F. Brown, pastor of the church, and the Rev. Raymond C. Lott, pastor of the Grinnell United Methodist Church, officiating.
