

Alfred Hicks Rites Held Friday Morning

Funeral services for Alfred A. Hicks were conducted by the Rev. Paul Septer Friday morning, January 2, at the Steffy Funeral Home. Music was provided by organist Miss Alice Underwood.

Mr. Hicks, 94, passed away Tuesday, December 30, in Montezuma. He was the last of a family of 12 children.

The son of Rebecca and Andrew Hicks, he was born Feb. 22, 1875, in Schuyler County, Mo. He attended a Missouri rural school and while a young man he was baptized in the Christian faith.

He was united in marriage to Charlotte Ann Logsdon and to this union three sons and one daughter were born. Mr.

Mr. Hicks maintained his home until three years ago when he came to Montezuma to be cared for by his son.
