

Services For Guy Hildebrand Held Monday

Funeral services for Guy Hildebrand were held Monday afternoon, Feb. 6, at the Steffy Funeral Home with the Rev. G. R. Dieken officiating. Music was provided by Mrs. Edwin Bryan, organist.

Guy, son of John and Esther Hildebrand, was born on June 19, 1882, near Forest Home, Poweshiek County, Iowa, and died in the Mahaska Hospital, Oskaloosa, on Friday, Feb. 3. He was 84.

He attended rural school and was a member of the Forest Home Christian Church.

On Jan. 19, 1905, he married Verda Cox and to this union six children were born. One son died in infancy.

Mr. Hildebrand devoted his life to farming. He served as a township trustee for several years. About four years ago Mr. and Mrs. Hildebrand retired and moved to their present home in Montezuma.

He is survived by his wife and their five children, Mrs. Faye Stutzman of Fremont, Ray and Leslie of Montezuma, John and Lester of Marion; eleven grandchildren and six great-grandchildren: four sisters, Mrs.
