

Mrs. Jas. L. Hill 9-20-1932 Passes Away

President J. S. Nollen has received word of the death of Mrs. James L. Hill at her home in Salem, Mass. Mrs. Hill survived only a few months her distinguished husband. Rev. James L. Hill, D.D., son of the man who gave the first dollar to found Grinnell college, graduate in the class of 1871 and for all his days a staunch friend of the college, which for many years he served as a trustee. Dr. Hill, with his brother, Ger-shom, founded the Hill Prizes in Extemporaneous Speaking and Sight Singing which are contested for every Commencement on the campus. Dr. Hill was a versatile speaker and a ready writer and left his mark on many varied activities.

Mrs. Hill was his true helpmeet throughout his long life. She visited Grinnell frequently with her husband and is remembered with affection by a great many people here, particularly those of the college community.
