

## Mrs. A. N. Hockett Dies On Tuesday; Services Today

Funeral services were conducted at 2 p.m. today for Mrs. Albert N. Hockett, 82, longtime Grinnell resident, who died Tuesday at the Soldiers Home hospital in Marshalltown, where she had been a patient since April 18.

The Rev. Rendel Cosand of the Northside Friends church here was in charge of the funeral services which were conducted at the Soldiers Home chapel.

Burial was in the Soldiers Home cemetery.

Survivors include her husband, who resides at the Soldiers Home; a son, Harold, of Des Moines; a brother, Jasper Sparks, of Grinnell; a half-sister, Cora Clark, of Riceville; one grandchild; and one great grandchild.

Born May 30, 1869, at Lynnville she was the daughter of Stephen J. and Rebecca Wolfe Sparks. She was married to Albert Hockett at Lynnville, Oct. 17, 1906.

For many years the Hocketts made their home here in Grinnell. Mrs. Hockett was a member of the Northside Friends church here.
