Laura Hoefert Rites Saturday

Laura Hoefert, 58, the wife of Dr. K. L. Hoefert of Grinnell, died Thursday evening, Aug. 27, at Grinnell General Hospital.

The daughter of David and Gertrude Dawson Sentman, she was born on Nov. 28, 1911, at Iowa City. She attended elementary schools at Tiffin, Iowa, and graduated from University High School in Iowa City. She also graduated from Irish Business College at Iowa City.

On May 29, 1935, she was married to Dr. K. L. Hoefert at Iowa City, and, following their marriage, they lived in Iowa City, moving to Grinnell in 1939.

She was a member of the United Methodist Church and served as its secretary for a number of years. She was also a member of the church's Women's Circle; Chapter A.U., T.T.T. Society; the Drummond Club and the Sunset Club.

She is survived by her husband; a son, John, serving in the U.S. Air Force at Tampa, Fla.; a daughter, Mrs. Robert (Dorothy) Lunsden of Carlisle; a son Donald, a student at Iowa State University; one grandson, David John Hoefert; two sisters, Mrs. Jack Bowen of Iowa City and Mrs. Lew Coggan of Floren Park, N. J.; and four brothers, Wayne Sentman of Iowa City, Earl Sentman of Stevens Point, Wis., and Purl and Leonard Sentman, both of Iowa City. She was preceded in death by her parents and one brother, Howard Sentman.

Funeral services for Mrs. Hoefert were held at 2 p.m. Satur-

day, Aug. 29, at the Grinnell United Methodist Church, with the Rev. J. Eugene Young officiating. Organist was Mrs. Kathleen Heffner, and pallbearers were Arthur McDowell, Stanley Steele, Kyle Jones, Clair Strand, Howard Timmes and Hugh McCleery. Burial was in Hazelwood Cemetery, with the James - Schalinske Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
