
Howard Hockett



Howard J. Hockett, 91, of Urbandale, formerly of Grinnell, died Monday, April 9, at Fleur Heights Care Center in Des Moines.

The son of Jonathan L. and Bertha Wieshausen Hockett, he was born Jan. 11, 1910, in Minitowoc, Wis. He was raised in Grinnell and received his education in Grinnell schools.

After his education, he was employed by Dairy Herd Improvement Association. He served with the U.S. Army during World War II. He received his B.S. degree in agricultural education from Iowa State University in 1955.

He was married to <u>Lucille M.</u> Larson June 29, 1940, in Guttenberg. He was a public school teacher in Manchester, Rockwell City and Rockford, Ill., prior to moving to McAllen, Texas in 1963, where he taught high school science. He retired in 1975, returned to Guttenberg, and lived in Grinnell for a year prior to making his home in Urbandale in 1998.

He was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Guttenberg and, later, Mt. Olive Lutheran Church in Des Moines. He was also a member of the American Legion.

Surviving is a sister, Myrtle. Gilbert of Grinnell. He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife; two sisters, Lenora Ohland and Bernice Sickinger; and one brother, Norman.
