OBITUARY

Alfred William Howell

Alfred William Howell, son of Fred and Margaret Howell, was born in Poweshiek county, near Grinnell on April 9, 1868, and passed away on Sunday morning, Oct. 19, 1952. He was 84 years old on last April 9.

When he was 3 years old he moved to a farm north of Bethel, where he resided until 1916 when he moved to the Westfield neighborhood. In 1931 he moved to the farm near Grinnell. On Nov. 23, 1892, he united in marriage with Eva Vaughan of Keokuk. To them five children were born, two of whom died in infancy. Three children survive, Ellen, Harry and Blanche, all of Grinnell. There are two grandsons, Kenneth of Mt. Vernon, Wash., and Charles of Camp Carson, Colo., and two

great granddaughters. There are also two nieces and one nephew.

Mr. Howell belonged to the Bethel church for a great number of years and regularly taught a Sunday school class. After he moved to the Westfield community he continued to teach a Sunday school class there. The Howells have belonged to the Grinnell church since 1939. After a lingering illness of over two years Mr. Howell passed away early Sunday morning. He will long be remembered for his constructive influence in the community and for his loving care of his family.
