

## Hubert Huizer

Hubert Huizer, 72, of Pella, formerly of Sully, died of leukemia Monday, June 2, at Pella Regional Health Center.

A committal service was conducted Friday at Sully Cemetery, and a memorial service was held later that morning at Second Reformed Church in Pella, with the Rev. Normal Schourten officiating.

He was born north of Galesburg Sept. 10, 1924. He was a graduate of Sully High School. On June 1, 1950, he was married to Joyce Borda at Sully. They farmed for several years in the Sully area, and Mr. Huizer also owned and operated a tiling business. The couple moved into Sully in 1969.

Mr. Huizer was employed by Castorf Camper Sales from 1976 until his retirement in 1988. He owned and managed apartments until the time of his death.

The couple had lived in Pella since 1979.

He was a member of the Second Reformed Church of Pella, the Red Rock Lake Association, the Pella Historical Society and the Marion County Historical Society.

Surviving are his wife; two daughters, Ronda Whitehorn of Roswell, Ga., and Sonya Prendergast of Braden, Miss.; one son, Mark of Sully; seven grandchildren; and one sister, Artie Vander Wilt of Sully.

He was preceded in death by his parents.
