## Victor Woman Dies Friday Morning In 1-Car Accident

Mrs. Hull was thrown from the car and hit the ground 75 feet from the place where the vehicle came to rest. She apparently died from internal injuries and was pronounced dead on arrival at a Marengo hospital, donfield, N.J., in a two-car ac-

There were no witnesses t about 9:30 a.m. The car, a 196 Ford, was demolished.
