Funeral services were held Saturday afternoon, Aug. 26, at the Nevenhoven Funeral Home in Brooklyn for Miss Ruth Hulse, 76, of Brookhaven Nursing home in Brooklyn, who died at Grinnell Regional Medical Center in Grinnell on Wednesday, Aug. 23, 2000.
