Kellogg Services Held Friday For Mrs. Henry Hum

Funeral services were held Friday from the Kellogg Methodist church for Mrs. Henry E. (Mabel) Hum, 92, of Grinnell.

Mrs. Hum died Oct. 24 at a local hospital.

Officiating at the services was the Rev. Lyle S. Dunham, pastor of the church. Interment was at Buffalo Center, Iowa.

Born in LaSalle county, Illinois, she was the daughter of O. E. and Nancy Dunham Gillham and came to Iowa when she was five years old. She resided near Eldora and received her education in the Hardin county schools.

In 1889, she was united in marriage with Henry E. Hum at Rough Woods, Iowa, and that same year they moved to Buffalo Center. Following the death of her husband in 1931, she moved to Kellogg to her home with a daughter, Mrs. Walter Paulson. Mrs. Hum moved to Grinnell about a year ago.
