James Humes, 81, Longtime Malcom Citizen, Succumbs

Funeral services were held Friday, Dec. 31st at Brooklyn for James Humes, 81, Malcom resident for 57 years who died Dec. 29th at an Iowa City hospital where he had been a patient for about three weeks.

Officiating at the services was the Rev. James Reynolds, pastor of the Malcom Methodist church. Organ music was provided by Mrs. Ed Bartachek.
