

Rites Today For Searsboro Woman, Nettie C. Hunter

Mrs. Nettie C. Hunter, wife of Hugh Hunter, Rte. 1, Searsboro, died suddenly Monday afternoon at a Grinnell hospital after an illness of more than two years.

Services for Mrs. Hunter were held this afternoon (Thursday) from the Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. Myrtle Lee of the Searsboro Friends church and Dr. G. S. Bruland of the Grinnell Methodist church officiating. Flower bearers were Mr. and Mrs. Oakley Sharn.

Mrs. Hunter was the daughter of David and Sarah Katherine Crooks Armstrong and was born on April 24th, 1880, at Rushville. She was united in marriage with Hugh Hunter on May 22nd, 1920 in Des Moines. They then made their home on a farm northwest of Searsboro. She was a member of the Searsboro Garden club and the Methodist church.

Survivors include her husband and one son, John T. Armstrong of Warpapello, Missouri, and four grandchildren and three great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents and two brothers.
