

Hold services for Mr. Husak ^{#-R July 19,} 1980

William Husak, 84, Toledo farmer and father of State Representative Emil Husak, died Saturday at Marshalltown Area Community Hospital, where he had been for three weeks.

He has been in failing health since February.

Funeral services for Mr. Husak were held at 10 a.m. Monday at St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Tama. Burial was at Holy Trinity Cemetery in rural Vining.

The rosary was recited Sunday evening at the Mason-Hand Funeral Home.

Born near Clutier on Nov. 11, 1895, he was the son of John and Agnes Psenica Husak. He attended Toledo High School, and married Mary Zmolek on Jan. 14, 1918, at Holy Trinity Church.

The couple always lived on the same farm near Toledo.

He is survived by his wife; six sons, Charles W., Paul J., John V., and Emil J. Husak, all of Toledo, William W. of Grinnell and Peter A. of Iowa City; two daughters, Mrs. Joseph (Julia) Benda of Elberon and Sister Mary Philomena Husak of the Sisters of Mercy Sacred Heart Covent in Cedar Rapids; two sisters, Mrs. Frank (Anna) Dvorak of Tama and Mrs. John (Hattie) Cibula of Toledo; and 23 grandchildren. One son, Adolph, preceded him in death.
