Body of Frank Hutchinson is Found in Pasture of his Father's

Coroner Friend Decided that Death was Due to Natural Causes

The body of Frank Hutchinson was found lying beside a hedge fence in a pasture on his father's farm seven miles south of Brooklyn about 7 o'clock Friday evening. He was quite dead but the body was still warm when discovered. Hutchinson, who inself a mile north of Honteguna, had gone to his father's farm in the morning 11 look after some coits. Neighbor: any the car standing there aridly and toward evening when it was still there they telephoned Mrs. Hutchinson and the search vas institution hed to the discovery of the body.

A pencil lying on the dead man's snest indicated that he had endeavored to write a last message but did not have strength to do so.

Coroner Friend was summoned but decided that death was due to natural causes, probably cooplexy, and that to inquest was necessary.

Hutchinson was 41 years old.
