

## Gerrit Huyser

Gerrit W. Huyser, 93, of Rte. 1, Sully, died Tuesday, March 10, at his home.

Services were conducted Friday, March 13, at the First Reformed Church of Sully, with the Rev. B. Daniel Hakken officiating. Organist was Adelaide Vande Krol. Pallbearers were his grandsons, Gordon, Doyle, Gregory, Bradley, Randall, Douglas, Daniel and Scott Huyser and Todd Renaud.

Burial was in Sully Cemetery, with the Vank Dyk-Duven Funeral Home of Pella in charge of arrangements.

The son of William C. and Cornelia Vander Wilt Huyser, he was born Aug. 9, 1898, on a farm south of Sully. He attended Chester rural school, then began farming with his mother, brothers and sisters.

He was married to Marie De Jong May 4, 1921, in Sully. They farmed south of Sully where they were living when Mrs. Huyser died in a car accident Jan. 14, 1943.

On March 15, 1945, he was married to Helen Gerdena De Penning in Sully.

Mr. Huyser was a member of the First Reformed Church where he served as a custodian for 20 years. He also had driven a school bus for the Lynnville-Sully School District for 11 years.
