George Iberg Funeral te Held At Rochester

Funeral services for George G. Iberg, 78, were held Friday, Dec. 2, at Rochester, Minn., and burial was in Cakwood cemetery there. Mr. Iberg died at his Rochester home Nov. 30,

Survivors include his wife, Thilda, of the home; two sons, Lowell Iberg, New York City, and Henry Iberg, Rochester; three grandsons; a sister and a brother in California, and another brother in Oregon.

Later they closed out and Iberg established a shoe store where the state liquor store is located. Henry Iberg and Ken were high school classmates, and Lowell was widely known as a violinist.
