

Orrie Icenbice ^{H 12} Services Today ^{6/11}

Orrie M. Icenbice, 78, Rte. 3, Grinnell, died Friday, June 11, at Grinnell General Hospital. He had been hospitalized since last Tuesday.

The son of Charles and Elizabeth Cranston Icenbice, he was born on July 10, 1892, at Deep River. He attended the rural schools of that community. On March 3, 1915, he was united in marriage to Margaret Cook at Deep River; following their marriage, they farmed in that area until 1942, when they moved to the Grinnell community and continued to farm. He was a member of the United Methodist church.

He is survived by his three children, Wayne Icenbice of Newburg, Mrs. Anna White of Kellogg, and Dale Icenbice of Grinnell; 10 grandchildren, five great-grandchildren; and a brother, Russell Icenbice of Sigourney. He was preceded in death by his wife on Sept. 14, 1966, his parents, a sister, a brother, a half-brother and his stepmother.
