California Rites Conducted For Mina Abel Imhoff

Word has been received here by Burdette Abel of the death of his sister, Mrs. Carl (Mina) Imhoff, in California on March 8th.

Funeral services were held March 9th and burial was in Oakwood cemetery, Chatsworth, Calif.

Mrs. Imhoff had been in poor health for several years. In November 1963, she gave up her apartment to live with her son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. Charles Probert, and her granddaughter, Julie Atkins, at Tarzana, Calif.

Mina Regina Abel Imhoff was the eldest daughter of Burdette A. (Burt) and Elda Wiler Abel. Her mother preceded her in death in 1909 and her father in 1930. Her husband died in 1953.
