Jacobs, 91, dies in Newton

Charles E. Jacobs, 91, of Embassy Manor, a former resident of Kellogg, died Sunday evening, Dec. 25, at the Skiff Memorial Hospital in Newton.

Funeral services for Charles Jacobs were held at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday at the Kellogg United Methodist Church. Burial was in Our Silent City Cemetery in Kellogg.

The son of John and Eva Jacobs, he was born on Sept. 4, 1886, in Monmouth, Ill. He married Emma B. Lenz on Sept. 17, 1913, at her parents' home near Kellogg.

A member of the Kellogg church and a former farmer, Charles Jacobs was also a retired employee of Mid-West Industries in Kellogg.

Surviving him are his wife; three sons, Leonard of Grand River, Bert of Nevada, and Delbert of Newton; a daughter, Mrs. Ben (Frances) Leonardo of Chicago Ridge, Ill.; a brother, Bill Jacobs of Embassy Manor; and a sister, Mrs. Lethel Straka of Minnetonka, Minn.
