**Ella Ringle Jacobs
Widely Known In
Poweshiek County**

Funeral services for Ella Ringle Jacobs were conducted at 10:30 a. m. Sept. 1 at the Steffy Funeral Home by the Rev. Frank Jacobs of the Methodist church. Miss Alice Underwood played the musical selections.

Interment was in the family lot in Golden Rod cemetery, Deep River. Casket bearers were Harold Lofgreen, Harold Swanson, Walter Fisch, Melvin Elliott, Joe Alexander and Art Goeke.

Ella, daughter of Samuei and Emma Ringle, was born near Deep River Nov. 27, 1877, and died in Montezuma Aug. 30, at 84 years of age. She attended rural school near Deep River.

On Feb. 25, 1895, she was united in marriage with Willard Jacobs, to this union, four children were born. Their entire married life was spent in the Deep River and Barnes City communities.

Mr. Jacobs died Dec. 4, 1927, and since that time Mrs. Jacobs has made her home in Montezuma. Since her health failed, she has been cared for in the Goeke Nursing Home.

She was a member of the Methodist church and the American Legion Auxliary.

She is survived by her four children, Cecil Clair Jacobs and Gertrude Hutchinson, Montezuma; Donald Jacobs, Rock Island, Ill., and Phyllis Beam, Chicago, Ill., nine grandchildren and 22 great grandchildren, other relatives and many friends.
