

## Marcus Jamison 6-26-1928 Passes Away

A large circle of former friends of the Jamison and Crane families will regret to learn of the death of Marcus Jamison who died last Friday at 12:45 p. m. at his home in Warren, Pa. Mr. Jamison was a bright young man in high school and college, clean and honorable, of highest character and a friend to all. He graduated from Grinnell College in 1883 and immediately went to Warren, Pa., where his father was the owner of some oil wells and refineries. He married Emily Crane, a member of the class of '83 soon after. He has been considered an exceptionally successful man in business and gave much attention to the care of his mother until she died and then to the care of his aunt, Emily Crane, who died only a few months ago.

Mr. Jamison had been ill for about a year and had spent a good deal of time in a sanitarium, high blood pressure and hardening of the arteries being the causes of his death. The senior of the Herald is one of those who knew Mr. Jamison well and regrets his death. He was an active, successful business man and lived a useful life.
