Herman Jansen rites today

Herman Jansen, 47, of Sully died Monday evening when the tractor he was operating rolled over an embankment.

The fatal accident occurred at the farm of his daughter and son-in-law, Joyce and Larry Van Wyk.

Funeral services were conducted at 1:30 p.m. today at the First Reformed Church of Sully, with the Revs. Daniel Hakken and Ralph Menning officiating. Burial will be at the Sully Cemetery, with the Garden Chapel Funeral Home of Pella in charge of arrangements.
