Mary Jantzen nee Baustian, born Aug. 3, 1855, in Meckienburg-Schwerin, Germany, was a member of the Lutheran church from infancy to death. Her friends will remember her as a patient, humble, singleminded Christian, whose mere quiet presence seemed to always cheer.

Deceased came to our country in 1862 and on July 26 of the same year was united in marriage to John Jantzen at Witertown, Wis.
