

MRS. ERNEST JARBOE

Mrs. Ernest Jarboe passed away at 12:00 o'clock Saturday noon, following a severe illness of about three months. She has been a resident of Grinnell all her life and has a large circle of intimate friends here.

Mrs. Eliza Schmitz Jarboe, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John Schmitz was born in Grinnell, Dec. 12, 1882, and departed this life, Sept. 18, 1920, aged 36 years and 9 months. Her girlhood days were spent on a farm four miles south of Grinnell.
