## Rites held for Mr. Jeffreys

Cecil R. Jeffreys, 73, of Kellogg died Monday, Dec. 10, at University Hospitals in Iowa City.

Funeral services were conducted at 2 p.m. Thursday at the Reese Chapel in Newton, with the Rev. Carl Klein, pastor of the Kellogg United Methodist Church, officiating. Burial was at Newton Union Cemetery.

A memorial in Mr. Jeffreys' name has been established with the Kellogg United Methodist Church.
