Was born in West Virginia, near Morgantown, December 14th, 1828. He missed being a "forty-niner" by only two years, as he crossed the continent to California in 1851. In the year 1857 he was married to Angeline Hibbs. To this union were born eight children, one dying in childhood, and two later in life. Those remaining are: Ambrose F., Mrs. Bede Beeler, Mrs. Edina Beeler and the Noble Pitman.
