

Peter Jenson Of Kellogg Passes

Kellogg, Ia., Dec. 13, Special:
Peter Jenson, resident of this vicinity for the past 49 years, died at his home Friday noon following an illness of thirteen months.

Mr. Jenson was born in Hebe, Sweden, Oct. 25, 1856. He came to America at the age of 25 years and was made a citizen three years later. He was united in marriage to Miss Charlotte Siegler Oct. 24, 1886 at Newton and four children were born of this union, two of whom preceded him in death.

He united with the Lutheran church in Sweden and later transferred his membership to the Kellogg Lutheran church.

Surviving relatives include his wife, Mrs. Charlotte Jenson, one son, Fred of Newton, one daughter, Mrs. J. E. Ellis of Sceptre, Saskatchewan, Canada, one brother, James Jenson of Omaha, fifteen grandchildren and one great granddaughter.

Funeral services were held from the Christian church Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock, with Rev. W. G. Weber, pastor of the local Lutheran church, in charge and burial was made in Our Silent City.
