Annie Johnson Rites Held At Brooklyn

Funeral services were conducted Thursday afternoon, January 2, at Bramer Funeral home, Brooklyn, for Annie B. Johnson who died Dec. 30 at Grinnell General hospital. The Rev. E. Edward Philgreen, pastor of Grace United Methodist church, was in charge. Mrs. Ed Bartachek was organist.

Interment was in Brooklyn I.O.O.F. cemetery. Casketbearers were Harvey Jones, Frank Herbrandt, Dean Lippincott, Dwayne Reed, Richard Williams and Irvin Nervig. Mr. and Mrs. Max Montgomery were flower attendants.
