

## Calvin Johnson Dies At Deep River

However he rallied and at times seemed to be gaining strength. But he had grown so weak that he fought a losing battle and death ensued. The funeral took place from the home at 2 p. m. Wednesday to Golden Rod, Rev. J. W. Chase, pastor of the Presbyterian church conducting the sad rites. — Record.
