Dale Everet Johnson, 52, of 1328 Main St., died Sunday afternoon of a heart attack while in Des Moines on family business. He had been agent for the Chicago & North Western Railroad here since 1956.

A memorial service for Mr. Johnson will be held later this week. It was his wish that his body be sent to the College of Medicine at the University of Iowa.
