George Emory Johnson, 84, of Lynnville died Saturday, Feb. 27, at Pella Community Hospital.

Funeral services were conducted at 2 p.m. Monday at the Harden Funeral Home in New Sharon, with the Rev. Kenneth L. Santee officiating.
