## Mrs. Bessie Jones, Former Grinnell Resident, Dies

Mrs. Walter (Bessie) Palmer Jones, 67, of Newton, former Grinnell resident, died Saturday morning at a Kirksville, Mo., hospital following an illness of the last year.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday from the Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. Chester Custer, pastor of the Methodist church, officiating. Organ music will be provided by Mrs. Willard Heffner.

Burial will be at an Ottumwa, Iowa, cemetery.
