Harold W. Jones, 72, of 1203 Spring St., died Wednesday morning, Aug. 2, at his home.

The son of Benjamin F. and Dortha Karsten Jones, he was born April 28, 1900, in Grinnell and had been a life-long resident of this community, attending its public schools.

He was married to Dorothy Bicknell Jan. 15, 1923, at Newton. Mr. Jones was employed by the Spaulding Company of Grinnell for many years in the washing machine department and also was a painter in the truck and car body departments. He was one of the last employees when the company closed down its production. For many years he had been a painting and decorating contractor and had only partially retired at the time of his death.
