

Mrs. Jennie Jones Dies In Omaha, Neb.

A telegram to Rev. P. A. Johnson Tuesday afternoon announced the death of Mrs. Jennie Jones, formerly of this city, in Omaha, Neb., at 1:43 o'clock p. m. Tuesday afternoon. The telegram was from Mrs. Jones' son, Marbeth. Funeral services were held this afternoon at Denson, Ill., at the residence of Will Brubaker.

Mrs. Jones and her son are well remembered by many childhood friends. They formerly lived in the Edson house, which occupied the site where the Catholic church now stands. The news of Mrs. Jones' death will be received with regret by all who knew her.

Mrs. Jones was treasurer of the Women's Home Missionary Union of the Congregational church for the state of Iowa for a number of years.

After leaving Grinnell she became secretary of the Y. W. C. A. in Marshalltown and later lived in Dodge and Sioux City. In recent years she has made her home with her son in Omaha.
