Rosa Heki Jones, 95, died
Thursday, Jan. 5, at St. Francis Manor.

Memorial servies were conducted Jan. 7 at the Lynnville Friends Church, with the Rev. Kenneth L. Santee officiating. Burial was at Woodland Cemetery near Lynnville, with the Harden Funeral Home of New Sharon in charge of arrangements.
