

## Mr. Kaisand rites today <sup>H-R March 11, 1982</sup>

Charles P. Kaisand, 88, of 627 East St., Grinnell, died Sunday, March 7, at St. Francis Manor.

Funeral services were conducted at 10:30 a.m. today at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Ann A. Estill, pastor of the Bethel Church, officiating. Organist was Alice Renaud, and pallbearers were Ray Irwin, Greg Kaisand, Roger Kaisand, Tom Savage, Roger Sparks and Ron Sparks. Honorary bearers were Francis Comerford, Gus Kaisand, John Krumm and Vern Millgate. Burial was at Hazelwood Cemetery.

He was married to Florence M. Jones on Aug. 5, 1912, and they farmed on several farms southwest of Grinnell, near Rock Creek Lake and south of Kellogg. He retired from farming in 1964 and moved to Grinnell.

He was preceded in death by his first wife in 1974, and on Sept. 18, 1975, he was married

to Florence Thompson in Grinnell. They continued to make their home here.

Mr. Kaisand was a charter member of the Bethel Grange and attended the Bethel Church.

He is survived by his wife, Florence; three daughters, Mildred E. Kaisand of Des Moines, Helen Sparks of Newton and Edith Hasselbrink of Newton; seven grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; and two sisters, Elizabeth M. Kaisand and Lela Tracy, both of the Mayflower Home.

He was preceded in death by his first wife; his parents; two sons, C. Kenneth Kaisand in 1978 and a son in infancy; three brothers, Jacob, Gustav and John Kaisand; and a sister, Anna Davis.
