Edwin D. Kasal, 66, of Rte. 1, Chelsea, died of a heart attack Thursday, Jan. 17, at his home.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Tama, with the Rev. Alfred Kaupins officiating. Burial was in Haven Cemetery, with the Mason-Hand Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
